

09 ENFIELD PARK

1205 NE Waverly Way 2.5 acre park located in the Kingsbury Subdivision with wide walking and bike trails, a 4-table pavilion and open turf area.

10 GILMORE PARK

SW 5th & SW D St. Adjacent to the Downtown Trail, this 1-acre neighborhood park has a playground, picnic tables, and fitness trail.

11 LAKE BENTONVILLE

2100 SW I St. A 20 acre park located 1/2 mile south of Hwy 102 on SW I St. Complete with picnic tables, playground and spacious settings. Fishing is allowed with appropriate license.

12 LAWRENCE PLAZA

215 NE A St. A 7,000 sq. ft. splash park during summer months and an outdoor ice rink in the winter. The splash park is a free fun spot for everyone to cool off May through September. The outdoor ice rink provides ice skating and fun for the entire family, November through January.

13 MELVIN FORD AQUATIC CENTER

2000 NE Memorial Park Square An Olympic size pool, separate slide and diving pool, and a wading pool.

14 MEMORIAL PARK

401 NE Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway This park includes tennis courts, sand volleyball courts, basketball courts, soccer fields, baseball fields, softball fields, and much more.

15 MERCHANTS BASEBALL PARK

201 Elm Tree Rd. The Merchants Baseball Park includes 4 fields as well as a newly constructed restroom/concession facility. The facility is named in honor of The Bentonville Merchants, a local Semi-Professional Baseball Team of the 1940's and 50's.

16 OLD TIGER STADIUM

517 Tiger Blvd. Six acres in size, it includes a track, full sized football field and a safe route to school trail that connects the school administration building and Lincoln Jr. High.

17 ORCHARDS PARK

1100 NE John DeShields Blvd. Across from Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art, this premier passive park with walking paths, beautiful landscaped areas, a pavilion, pond with water feature, and amphitheater that is the home to Bentonville's 4th of July and Easter celebrations.

18 PARK SPRINGS PARK

300 NW 10th St. A large covered pavilion, complete with several picnic tables and a fireplace, can comfortably host large groups for special events. Lots of shade trees adjoined with a single track mountain bike trail.

19 PHILLIPS PARK

3108 SE J St. A 40 acre community park featuring 5 lighted baseball fields, 2 t-ball fields, 2 lighted multi-purpose fields, a play structure, restrooms and concession stand.

20 SLAUGHTER PEN MTN BIKE PARK

North of NW A St. & East of N. Walton Blvd.

This single-track trail has been designed specifically for mountain bikers. This trail system incorporates progressive features, but also provides alternatives for riders of all levels.

21 TOWN BRANCH PARK

401 SE 2nd St. Located just off Central Ave., southeast of the Benton County Administration Building. Serves as the trailhead for the Town Branch Trail with a gazebo.

22 TRAIN STATION PARK

400 S. Main St. Across from the Bentonville Public Library, with a gazebo, benches, and beautiful landscaping in a passive setting adjacent to the Downtown Trail.

22 WILDWOOD PARK

3800 Bright Road A 1.5 acre neighborhood park complete with 2 tennis courts, picnic pavilion, play structure, and restrooms.

PARK RULES

Please enjoy using the Bentonville Parks System. To ensure that it is a pleasant experience for all of our users, please follow these rules and guidelines, adopted by city ordinance, in all Bentonville Parks.

Bentonville Parks are open from sunrise to 11pm.

Do not tamper with park property without prior written consent from Bentonville Parks & Recreation.

Do not litter in parks. If you have an event, please clean up after your event has concluded.

Parking on grass is prohibited.

Disorderly or unlawful conduct will not be tolerated.

Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited.

Fires are prohibited, except in fireplaces or grills.

Weapons and/or firearms are prohibited.

Fireworks are prohibited.

Merchandising is not permitted without written consent from Bentonville Parks & Recreation.

All dogs must be on a leash, with the exception of the Bentonville Bark Park.

Always clean up after your pet.

YOUR GUIDE TO PLAY! IN
BENTONVILLE PARKS

01 AUSTIN-BAGGETT PARK

601 SE D St. This 1.2 acre neighborhood park includes a playground, pavilion, and picnic areas.

02 BARK PARK

2400 N. Walton Blvd. An off-leash recreation area for dogs. Provides exercise and socialization opportunities for canines, while promoting responsible dog ownership with events and programs.

03 BELLA VISTA LAKE

Off of Hwy 71 B North A 132 acre community park includes a loop fitness trail, covered pavilion, and play structure.

04 BENTONVILLE COMMUNITY CENTER

1101 SW Citizens Circle This 80,000 square foot facility serves residents of all ages. Amenities include an aquatic center featuring a zero-depth entry, family leisure pool and a 25 yard, competitive pool. The center features a fitness center, dance/aerobics studio, gymnasium, indoor running track, community rooms, arts and craft room, senior activity lounge and more.

05 CITIZENS PARK

1101 SW Citizens Circle This 35 acre park surrounding the Bentonville Community Center will grow to include multipurpose fields, playgrounds, pavilions, and more.

06 DAVE PEEL PARK

206 East Central Ave. A 2 acre mini-park located one block east of the City Square. A local favorite for families with young children with playgrounds for various ages, a pavilion, restrooms, and several picnic tables.

07 DOWNTOWN ACTIVITY CENTER

215 SW A St. This 8,378 square foot facility is home to the Bentonville Parks & Recreation Administrative Staff, conference room, and host to several wellness classes each week.

08 DOWNTOWN BENTONVILLE SQUARE

1 East Central Ave. Centrally located in the middle of downtown Bentonville with access to Walton's Five & Dime, Crystal Bridges Trail, Lawrence Plaza, Compton Gardens, and retail shops and restaurants.

08 DURHAM PLACE PARK

SE 8th St. A neighborhood park with a play structure and picnic shelter.




