New Business

Couglin Property Master Plan Presentation / Review

David reviewed the Coughlin Property drafts of the project with everyone. The committee suggested on page one, #4 – Playground or Splash Pad Play Area be flipped with #1 – Pavilion. Also discussed was visiting with the school about the land they own and the possibility of them donating this land to Parks and Recreation in order to build a parking lot. It was suggested to have restrooms the same size of Citizens Park restrooms.

Sreenivas Parise attended this meeting to share information about needing cricket fields in Bentonville. He has been working on this project for 20 years. He shared the following information.

- Hold local tournaments
- Generate revenue for area
- Great need due to demographic
- Keep locals in community vs traveling to other parts of state
- Spring and Fall leagues (30 teams 15-20 members on team)
- League currently consists of adult males
- Requesting lights and pitch to be set

David confirmed the committee members were all on board with the two proposals below:

- 1.) Overall concept of masterplan
- 2.) Two Cricket fields (one permanent one temporary) (This includes one at Memorial Park)

He will return this to the design team for a final plan copy which will include a larger restroom.

2019 Budget Presentation

Crant Osborn and Lee Farmer detailed budget for 2019. This information was also detailed on spreadsheet shared during meeting. We will install turf on five baseball fields in 2019. The committee members had a few concerns with Durham Park and if we need to remove this park mainly due to safety issues. We are not able to repair the existing playground equipment because it is outdated. Also, there will continue to be a lot of construction in that area with growth of community. No decision was made on Durham Park.
